	A soft ripe nose with touches of pineapple and a floral edge lead to a well-made, balanced structure in the mouth, with hints of guava and apricot. Soft, easy drinking. *2			
2	Cuvée Jean Paul Sec, France	£3.40	£4.40	£13.30
	The ultimate party wine. The deliciously fresh and fragrant nose is followed by crisp green fruit and lively acidity. *1			
3	Cuvée Jean Paul Demi-Sec, France	£3.40	£4.40	£13.30
	If you prefer an off-dry style of white then look no further. This stuff is so well designed for the easy drinking bracket that its very hard to keep your glass full! *5			
4	Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc, Chile			£14.80
	Pale straw in colour, this is your archetypal Sauvignon Blanc. Ripe peaches and pineapple hit you first then you get the flavours of exotic tropical fruits like guava, mangos and pineapples. The wine is fresh tasting with a good balance of acidity. *2			
5	Conviviale Pinot Grigio, Italy			£15.50
	A crisp and lively dry white, lightly aromatic with characters of peach and citrus fruits on the nose. Medium bodied with fresh lemony fruit and underlying hints of nuts and a gently honeyed finish. *2			
6	Lantana Semillon Chardonnay, Australia			£16.50
	A lovely, easy drinking blend from a quality producer. Fresh, clean tropical fruit flavours dominate. *3			
7	Kreuznacher Kabinett Riesling, Germany			£14.95
	The Riesling make up gives this wine a considerable advantage over many others in its price bracket. Fruity and fresh tasting, its elegant apple and melon flavours make it instantly appealing. *5			
8	False Bay Wild Yeast Chenin Blanc, South Africa			£17.95
	A rich swirl of Chenin characters with gentle ripe apple aromas, honeyed aromatics and delicious greengage and citrus lemon acidity on the long finish. The terrifically generous mouth feel comes from the long, slow wild yeast fermentation. *3			
9	Rustenberg Brampton Unoaked Chardonnay, South Africa			£18.50
	A lovely mouthful of fruit and toasted nuts with all the creaminess you would expect from a chardonnay. This stuff rivals many Aussie efforts at a much higher price. *2			
10	Pascal Bouchard Chablis, France			£24.95
	The nose is generous with elegant and subtle shades of fruit, dominated by apples and peaches. The mineral character of this Chablis, almost gun-flinty, is the flavour that persists after the lively straight forward taste which characterizes all of Chablis. Rich, full and long on the palate. *1			
11	Dog Point Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand			£28.00
	Brimming with fruit this wine has that wonderful freshness we associate with quality Kiwi Sauvignon. Both an aperitif and a partner for many first course dishes or white fish. *2

| A nice light hue to this rosé which promises, and delivers, a good depth of fruit. There is a nice aroma of rhubarb and a hint of sweetness on the finish. *2 | | | | |

| A lovely, soft blackcurrant fruit core is backed up by a touch of woodspice in this quaffable red from the heart of Spain. *C | | | | |
| 19 | Cuvée Jean Paul Rouge, France | £3.40 | £4.40 | £13.30 |
| Light style French red with red berried fruits and cranberry flavours, very easy drinking. *A | | | | |
| 20 | Le Tenute Merlot, Italy | | | £14.80 |
| Dark ruby red. Soft, fruity mouthful with the velvety tannin structure expected from a well made merlot wine. *B | | | | |
| 21 | Bodegas Navajas Tinto Rioja, Spain | | | £15.50 |
| This bright red Rioja benefits from 3 months in oak and punches well above it's weight in quality with lovely berried fruits nicely integrated with a smokey wood background. *C | | | | |
| 22 | Giacomo Montresor Valpolicella Classico, Italy | | | £16.70 |
| Lots of classic ripe flavours that encapsulate the unmistakable feel of a classic Italian red made from 100% corvine grapes. Deep clear ruby red colour. A bouquet with typical almond and cinnamon tones. A strong dry velvety taste with scents of cherry, musk, spices and wood. *B | | | | |
| 23 | Murphy's 'Big Rivers' Shiraz, Australia | | | £17.90 |
| Soft, bramble berry fruit packed with a hint of pepper. This shiraz is very smooth and easy drinking. *D | | | | |
| 24 | Abadal Cabernet Franc Tempranillo, Spain | | | £18.50 |
| Fragrances of berries (raspberry and currant) on an elegant fund of toffee and apricot. In the mouth, it is fresh and powerful with a long end where its fruit-bearing character is intertwined with minerals typical of the Cabernet Franc and with a hint of sweetness. *B | | | | |
| 25 | Urban Uco Malbec, Argentina | | | £18.50 |
| Ripe but focused, with a nice beam of crushed raspberry, roasted vanilla and cocoa running along plush, medium-weight tannins. Smooth and easy drinking. *D | | | | |
| 26 | Poggiotondo Cerro del Masso Chianti, Italy | | | £18.95 |
| This delicious medium-bodied Chianti possesses refreshing acidity and notes of red cherry and hints of spice. It is made from Sangiovese grapes blended with a small proportion of Merlot all grown in Tuscany. *C | | | | |
| 27 | Chateau Du Souzy Beaujolais Villages, France | | | £20.95 |
| A delicious cherry scented, fresh ripe Beaujolais Villages from a vintage described by many from the region as the best in living memory! *A | | | | |
| 28 | Rousseau De Sipian Cabernet Merlot Bordeaux 2005, France | | | £23.00 |
| This wine enjoys a classic nose of cloves, spice, pepper and dark cherries and a full, rich palate which has hints of chocolate and tar with good structure and length. *D | | | | |
| 29 | McManis Family Vineyards PINOT NOIR, USA | | | £24.00 |
| Aromas of Cherry, Strawberry and Violets. Adding to the intrigue of this wine, are notes of Vanilla and Cola which are contributed by the oak aging. Full of berry fruit, the flavor of this rich wine remains long after swallowing. *B | | | | |
